SELECTION CRITERIA AND SYLLABUS FOR WRITTEN EXAMINATION

As per notification issued by the State Govt. vide No. G.S.R-25/Const./Art. 309/217 dated 13.12.2017 and further clarification issued vide Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana letter No. 22/28/2003-3GS III dated 25.8.2018, adopted by LUVAS, Hisar with the approval of competent authority, a total of 100 marks will be available for scoring which include written examination of 90 marks and 10 marks for socio-economic and experience for selection to a post of Group C & D.

The written exam shall be divided into two portions comprising (90 Marks)

1. 75% weightage for General Awareness, Reasoning, Math, Science, English, Hindi and concerned or relevant subjects, as applicable;
2. 25% weightage for History, Current affairs, Literature, Geography, Civics, Environment, Culture etc. of Haryana

To qualify point(2) above, the candidates would have to score minimum 50% marks and the proportion of question shall be decided by the University at its own level.

Socio economic criteria and experience (10 marks)

The marks for experience and some objective socio-economic criteria will be allocated as follows:-

- a. If no person from among the applicant's father, mother, spouse, brothers, sons and daughters is, was or has been a regular employee in any Department/Board/Corporations/Company /Statutory Body / Commission/Authority of Government of Haryana or any other State Government or Government of India.

(5 Marks)

- b. Orphan/Widow:-

- i. If the applicant is a Window; or
- ii. If the applicant is the first or the second child and his father had died before attaining the age of 42 years; or
- iii. If the applicant is the first or the second child and his father had died before the applicant had attained the age of 15 years.

(5 Marks)

- c. If the applicant belongs to such a denotified tribe (vimukt jatis and Tapriwas jatis) or Nomadic tribe of Haryana which is neither a Scheduled Caste nor a Backward class.

(5 Marks)

- d. Experience: One-half (0.5) marks for each year thereof exceeding six months of experience, out of a maximum of 10 years, on the same or a higher post in any Department/Board/Corporations/Company/Statutory Body of Haryana. No marks will be awarded for any period less than six months.

(Maximum of 5 Marks)

No applicant shall be given more than 10 marks under any circumstances.

For the post of Veterinary Surgeon, the candidates will be short listed on the basis of written test, if the number of the applicants are more than ten times the number of vacancy. The syllabus and selection criteria for the same will be notified separately.
