IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read the prospectus carefully before filling the application form. The completed application should be submitted to The Registrar, LLRUVAS, Hisar-125004.
2. Strictly adhere to the last date for submission of the application. No correspondence will be entertained for rejection of the application, if received after the scheduled date.
3. The application form should be filled in carefully and no column be left blank. All entries especially category should be legibly filled in. Once the application is submitted, no change in category is permissible. In case, category is not clearly indicated in the application, it will be treated for General category. If any column is not applicable, it may be marked as not applicable using abbreviation-NA. Once admitted the student will not be allowed to shift from payment seats to general seats.
4. Non-submission of required documents with the application or non-production of original documents and the attested copies at the time of counselling shall make a candidate ineligible for admission. The candidate must bring 5-6 Pass Port sized colored photographs at the time of counselling. Attendance in person at counselling and registration is compulsory.
5. Every student is required to attend at least 75% of the lectures delivered and practicals conducted, separately in each course from the start of the classes of a semester, for being eligible to appear in the final examination.
6. Name of such student, whose attendance in aggregate is below 33% at the end of the academic year shall be struck off.
7. **Ragging is banned with zero tolerance in the University. The University follows the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 as well as the directions given by the Hon'ble Apex Court in this regard.**
8. **If any incidence of ragging comes to the notice of the University Authority, strict action will be taken as per rules.**
9. The university has imposed a ban on use of motorized vehicles in hostel.

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CHAPTER-1

INTERPRETATION OF RULES & REGULATIONS

In the event of any inconsistency amongst the rules framed for admission policy or in the event of any clarification with respect to the above said rules, the matter shall be referred to the Vice-Chancellor and the interpretation given by the Vice-Chancellor shall be final. The Vice-Chancellor is also competent to eliminate any inconsistency and decide as to which provision shall take precedence over the others.

REMEDIES

If any applicant has any grievance or is of the opinion that in his/her case, the rules framed for admission have not been followed, in that event he/she shall make an application outlining clearly the grievance/deviation in his/her opinion to the Vice-Chancellor. The Vice-Chancellor shall consider the application in the light of relevant rules and his decision in the matter shall be final.

INTRODUCTION

MEANING AND SCOPE OF THE PROSPECTUS

It is a brief compilation of informations and not an exhaustive detail of all the regulations made by the competent authority in this regard. The provisions of the Prospectus are in the shape of guidelines which are available to the applicants seeking admission and do not in any manner limit the power of any Competent Authority in making additional regulations regarding the admission of the students in the University from time to time.

Admissions are made in accordance with the admission rules. Since it is not possible to mention detailed procedure in the Prospectus, admission rules are to be read with the instructions issued/to be issued from time to time with the approval of the Academic Council/Competent Authority.

COMPETENT AUTHORITY

The original jurisdiction to make regulations regarding the admission of the students in the University is vested in the Academic Council of Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Hisar (Established by Haryana Legislature Act No.7, 2010 here after referred to as Act, 2010). The provisions as reproduced in the Prospectus or the guidelines as provided in this Prospectus shall not make precedence over the powers of the Academic Council as provided in Section 15 of the Act, 2010 and the powers of the Vice-Chancellor as contained in Section 21 of the Act, 2010 and any of the provisions of the Act, 2010 and the subsequent Statutes framed by the University from time to time.

The provisions or guidelines provided in the Prospectus are not final and are subject to modifications made by the Competent Authority under the Act & Statutes and if superseded by such decision by the Competent Authority, the latter will prevail and the information given in the Prospectus shall stand modified to that extent automatically.

THE UNIVERSITY

The Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, was established under Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Hisar Act, 2010 and started functioning with effect from December 01, 2010 at Hisar to serve the society by promoting the livestock production, health and prevention of the diseases through integrated teaching, research and extension programmes.

THE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

The main campus of the University is situated at Hisar at a distance of about 172 KM North West of Delhi on National Highway No.10 and is 2 ½ KM from the railway station and 3 KM from the Bus Stand.

THE COLLEGE OF VETERINARY SCIENCES

This College is a daughter institution of the erstwhile Punjab Veterinary College, Lahore, Pakistan which was bifurcated at the time of partition. Initially, a Camp Veterinary College was established at Hisar in 1948 which became a constituent college of Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana in 1960's. Thereafter, the college became part of the Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar and subsequently, CCSHAU, Hisar. Now, it is the constituent college of Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar. The college is a centre of regional, national and international excellence for learning in animal health and production. It caters to the needs of Haryana by carrying out teaching, research and extension education programmes pertaining to livestock health and production and has been instrumental in ushering an era of 'White Revolution' in the State.

The college has highly competent and experienced faculty with significant contributions in research on animal health and production that has won various national and international awards. The Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education Degree Course (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Regulations, 1993 of Veterinary Council of India (VCI), subsequently revised in 2008, have been implemented in the college. This college has 16 departments having excellent laboratory facilities and adequate infrastructure for the undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and research, a well equipped teaching veterinary clinical complex catering to the needs of large and small animal health care. The college offers the following programmes of study:

- (i) Veterinary Live Stock Development Diploma
- (ii) Bachelor of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry
- (iii) Master of Veterinary Science
- (iii) Doctor of Philosophy

The successful completion of B.V.Sc. & A.H. (veterinary education degree course) from this college entitles the graduates for registration with the Haryana State Veterinary Council / Veterinary Council of India as registered veterinary practitioners.

LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SERVICES

Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar is presently sharing the library and information services of CCSHAU, Hisar through its Nehru Library which is housed in a centrally located elegant building. The library opens for 15-16 hours daily throughout the year. It has six Reading Halls with cozy reading environment where 650 readers can sit and study at a time. Book Bank is a very popular service with the students who are entitled to borrow four textbooks each from its collection at nominal charges. Bookshop is a service unique to this library as no other library supports this activity. The students and teachers can buy books from the Bookshop at discounts ranging from 10 to 35% against a market discount structure of 10-15%. Photocopying service is provided at nominal rates.

Videoconferencing facility, multimedia library, internet lab, more than 2387 e-journals etc are the other facilities available in the library. The Library also provides full text access to more than 4000 Agricultural Doctoral Dissertations submitted to all SAUs/DAUs during the years 2000-07.

DIRECTORATE OF STUDENTS' WELFARE

The Directorate is responsible for the welfare of students and helps in their counselling and placement, cultural and sports activities. Presently, Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar, with its own hostels, is sharing the students' welfare facilities of CCSHAU, Hisar.

(A) GIRI CENTRE FOR SPORTS ACTIVITIES

The Girl Centre for students' sports activities is an outstanding feature being shared by the University. It has two indoor badminton courts, two indoor squash courts, hobby rooms, two multipurpose indoor gymnasiums. A synthetic track of international standard has also been provided in the athletic stadium.

(B) HOSTEL FACILITIES

Accommodation is provided in hostels where all the facilities such as gas connection, furniture, TV with cable connection, leading News Papers and Magazines and solar water heating system are provided. All the hostels have EPABX phone facilities as well as incoming calls facilities. Two hostel wardens look after the management of each hostel. Every hostel has been provided with water coolers having Aqua-Guard for safe drinking water. The hostel messes are being run on co-operative basis.

(C) CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Directorate is also responsible for promotion of all co-curricular activities such as Sports, NCC, NSS, Mountaineering, Graphic Arts, Literary, Music, Dance, Drama, NIS etc.

(D) STUDENTS' COUNSELLING AND PLACEMENT CELL

The Counselling & Placement Cell of the University provides information to the students on job opportunities, competitive examinations, scholarships/fellowship etc. It also conducts trainings/coaching classes for the entrance examination, personality development and explores the job opportunities in the public and private sectors and arranges the campus interviews.

MEDICAL SERVICES

There is a well-equipped 50 bed Hospital in the Campus. The Hospital has physicians, a surgeon, and a dentist. Medical aid is provided round the clock to the students, staff and other trainees.

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING B.V.Sc. & A.H. ADMISSIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY, APPLICATION FORM AND ADMIT CARDS

- 1.1 The minimum educational qualification required for admission is 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English or equivalent from a recognized Board/ University with at least 50 % marks in aggregate in these four subjects (40 % for SC & BC categories). Minimum age should be 17 years on or before 31st December, 2012.
- 1.2 The applicants seeking admission to the B.V.Sc & A.H. degree programme may download the Application Form and two Admit Cards from the University website: www.llruvas.edu.in. The last date for receipt of duly filled in Application Form along with Two Admit Cards in the office of The Registrar, LLRUVAS, Hisar - 125004 is 14-05-2012 without late fee and 21-05-2012 with additional late fee of Rs. 400/-

1.3 DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Demand Draft of Rs. 2000/- for general, Rs. 500/- for SC&BC and Rs. 3000/- for NRI/NRI sponsored/Industry sponsored applicants in favour of Comptroller, LLRUVAS, Hisar payable at Hisar. Rupees 200/- (General Category) and Rs. 50/- (SC/BC Category) may be added if printed version of the prospectus is desired by the applicant. Printed version can be sent by post on receipt of DD.
- b) Attested copy of SC/BC/Persons with disability category certificate, as applicable.
- c) Attested copy of NRI/NRI sponsored (NRIS)/Industry sponsored (IS) certificate/ Kashmiri Migrant (KM)/Ex-serviceman/Freedom Fighter, as applicable.
- d) Three attested recent passport size coloured Photos to be pasted each on Application Form and Two Admit cards.
- e) Attested copy of Matriculation Certificate.
- f) 9"x 4" self addressed envelope affixed with Rs. 25/- postage stamp.

Note 1. The Photographs (taken on or after 01-10-2011) should depict name and date of taking photo and it should be without cap and dark glasses. If the photographs are old, are not similar or are with cap or dark glasses or disfigured by attesting authority, the application shall be rejected.

Attestation of photograph is to be done by Gazetted Officer/Principal of School/College last attended (avoid attestation on the face).

Note 2. The original documents and their attested copies are to be submitted at the time of counselling as per rule 4.8 of this chapter.

Note 3. The fee paid shall neither be refunded nor adjusted under any circumstances except under rule 4.2 of this chapter. No tuition fees will be charged for Persons with disability and women candidates of any category.

2. PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION-CUM-COUNSELLING:

General Rules:

- 2.1 Applications received after the scheduled date shall be rejected. Admit Cards will not be issued in cases where entrance /counselling fee & late fee, if applicable, is not attached with the application. The applicants should ensure submission of documents as per rule 1.3 of this chapter; otherwise admit cards will not be issued. The Competent Authority reserves the right to reject any application for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- 2.2 All eligible candidates must report themselves on the date and time for Counselling failing which they will have no claim for admission. No separate letter in this connection shall be issued.
- 2.3 **Candidates are required to bring the required original documents and the attested copies as per rule 4.8 of this chapter at the time of counselling, failing which they shall be refused admission.** Original documents of admitted students shall be retained by Registrar's office and temporarily provided to the student on demand for a week or the student shall have to return original certificates a day before the second counselling, whichever is earlier and if not returned by the date committed, admission shall stand automatically cancelled. Finally, these will be returned through the Dean within one month after cut off date/ registration whichever is later.
- 2.4 Admissions will be completed at second counselling which will be the cut off date for admissions against vacant seats, if any.
- 2.5 The applications along with enclosed documents of those candidates who are not admitted even during second counselling / cut off date, shall be destroyed within three months barring the court cases, if any.

3. ENTRANCE TEST

- 3.1 All candidates including NRI sponsored/industry sponsored (except NRI) seeking admissions to B.V.Sc.&A.H. programme will have to appear in Entrance Test (ET) to be held at Hisar on **04-08-2012 (Monday) at 10.00 a.m.**
- 3.2 The applicants who fulfill the minimum eligibility conditions or have appeared in 10+2 or equivalent examination with required subjects (even if result is yet to be declared), shall be issued admit cards by post. In case admit card is not received, the applicant should contact in person the office of Registrar on **30-05-2012** and **31-05-2012** by 2:00 p.m. for issuing the duplicate Admit Card on payment of Rs.200/-. For this purpose, the applicant should bring **one photo exactly similar**

to the attested coloured passport size photograph pasted on Application Form and Admit Cards.

- 3.3 Syllabus of entrance test will be the same as the syllabi of 10+1 and 10+2 of Board of School Education, Haryana /C.B.S.E., New Delhi.

The subject wise questions and marks will be as under:

Duration of test: 10.00 a.m to 1.00 p.m.

(30 minutes meant for completing pre-examination formalities and 2 ½ hours for answering the question paper).

Medium of test shall be English. All 200 questions will be of multiple choice.

There will be no negative marking.

- 3.4 General Instructions for Entrance Test

1. Entry to the test centre will not be allowed without a valid Admit Card.
2. **ENTRY IN ANY CASE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AFTER 10:15 a.m.**
3. Every candidate must sign again on the admit card available with supervisory staff during the Entrance Test.
4. The candidates must bring with them **two ball pens with blue or black ink only**. Electronic devices such as calculator, mobile phones etc. are not allowed. The OMR sheet of such candidate who uses pencil or ball pen of any other colour or mixed blue and black colour shall not be evaluated and thus debarred from admission.
5. Before using the OMR sheet, the candidate must carefully check the question booklet and report the shortcoming, if any, to the supervisory staff. **Once the candidate starts writing on the OMR sheet, no replacement shall be allowed.**
6. Cuttings and over writings are not allowed on OMR sheet. Such answers will not be considered.
7. The OMR sheet should not be folded and no rough work is to be done on OMR sheet.

- 3.5 The result of the entrance test shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Dean, College of Veterinary Sciences and shall also be available on University website: **www.lruvas.edu.in**

- 3.6 There is no provision for re-checking or re-evaluation of answer sheets and no enquiry in this regard shall be entertained.

- 3.7 Use of unfair means in Entrance Test-Penalty thereof:

- i) Candidate(s) found guilty for use of unfair means or misconduct (as defined below) shall be expelled from the entrance test by Centre Superintendent/Registrar and their decision shall be final.
- (a). Creating disturbance of any kind during entrance test or otherwise misbehaving in or around the entrance test centre or refusing to obey the Superintendent/Supervisor or changing his/her seat with any candidate.
 - b). Writing his/her name or putting any identification mark on the outer cover of question booklet or anywhere in the OMR sheet. Having in his/her possession or accessible to him/her papers/books/notes which may possibly be of any assistance to him/her or found giving or receiving assistance or copying from any paper/book/notes or allowing any other candidate to copy from his/her OMR sheet or found writing on a paper other than his/her question booklet & OMR sheet or using or attempting to use any other unfair means during the entrance test.
 - c). Tampering with his/her roll number on the OMR sheet.
 - d). Using cellular phone or any such device inside entrance test centre.
- ii) Any candidate found impersonating for another candidate or found being impersonated by another candidate during the entrance test, apart from expulsion from entrance test, shall be debarred from seeking admission in this University for two subsequent academic sessions and the case may be registered with the local police.
- iii) If use of unfair means is detected at the time of evaluation of OMR sheets/ counselling or thereafter, the candidate shall be disqualified and admission cancelled as the case may be and debarred from seeking admission in this University for two subsequent academic sessions.

3.8 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The eligible candidates shall be required to report on **18-06-2012** at **09.30 a.m.** in the Auditorium of College of Veterinary Sciences for counselling and further verification and submission of documents to the Admission Committee. Admission shall be allowed on the basis of merit in the Entrance Test and availability of seat(s) and the **candidates admitted shall have to pay fee and other charges there and then.**

3.9 SAME MARKS IN ENTRANCE TEST OR OTHERWISE

If there are two or more candidates scoring same marks in the entrance test, the merit amongst them shall be decided on the basis of % marks obtained in the qualifying examination. If in the qualifying examination, the percentage of marks remains the same, then the merit will be decided on the basis of lower board's examination. If still there is a tie, then the candidate senior in age will be considered higher in merit.

Every candidate who has deposited the fee and other charges must report for registration on due date, failing which he/she shall lose the claim of admission and his/her fee will also be forfeited.

4. GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING ADMISSIONS

- 4.1 No intimation letter regarding counselling or registration shall be sent to any candidate. Admission of foreigners shall, however, be made in absentia on the basis of documents received through the Competent Authority. Sponsoring Authority will be informed about admission of foreigners with a copy to the candidate.
- 4.2 After the deposition of the fee and other charges, the candidates shall get themselves medically examined from the Senior Medical Officer of the University, submit medical certificate on the same day to the Dean of the College and complete the registration on due date as indicated in Annexure-I. The fee deposited by the candidate who is found medically unfit shall be refunded and his/her admission shall stand cancelled. The admission of those candidates, who fail to report for registration on the scheduled date, shall also stand cancelled and dues paid shall not be refunded.
- 4.3 The candidates shall be admitted as per roster system in Annexure-II. However, while filling the seats earmarked for general category, the combined merit list having reserved categories' candidates too, shall be considered. Any candidate who remains absent on being called or refuses to accept admission on his/her turn as per roster system shall lose his/her right of admission even for the second counselling.
- 4.4 Admission against reserved seats
In case of seats reserved for different categories (excluding general category), the merit will be determined inter se amongst the Haryana domiciled candidates belonging to the respective categories. Roster system as in Annexure-II shall be followed for admitting the candidates belonging to various reserved categories. However, while filling the general category seats under roster system, the combined merit list having reserved categories' candidates too, shall be considered. Seats lying vacant in any reserved category due to non-availability of eligible candidates will be added to general category and filled up in 1st counselling itself, if possible.
- 4.5 The completion of admission process involves the following:
- i) Submission of all original documents along with attested copies and verification at the time of counselling.
 - ii) Deposition of fee and other charges.
 - iii) Medical Examination.
 - iv) Registration on due date.
- Admission procedure will be completed only after registration.
- 4.6 Seats remaining vacant due to any reason at the first counselling or the seats fallen vacant subsequently due to any reason shall be filled in during 2nd counselling/cut off date for the admissions as indicated in Annexure-I.
"At the time of second counselling, only the remaining candidates after the last admitted in each category shall be considered in order of merit against the vacant seats".
There will be no admission after the cutoff date and seat(s) still remaining vacant shall be treated as cancelled.

4.7 Presence of Candidates

Presence of the candidate is must for the following events failing which the admission shall be treated as cancelled and the dues already deposited shall stand forfeited and the seat considered vacant and filled up as per rules:

- i) 1st counselling for admission at date and time indicated in Annexure-I.
- ii) 2nd counselling, if interested to be considered for admission as per rule 4.6 of this chapter.
- iii) Medical examination.
- iv) Registration as per Annexure-I.

4.8 Original and self-attested copies of the following documents are required to be deposited with the Admission Committee at the time of counselling and failure to produce any of the original documents shall make the candidate ineligible for the admission:

- i) Matric Certificate with Date of Birth and Father's/Mother's name.
- ii) 10+2 certificate or equivalent.
- iii) Haryana Resident Certificate (Annexure-III).
- iv) Character Certificate from the institute last attended. The applicants who have passed qualifying examination earlier and there is a gap of more than one year (other than the pursuit of studies in an institution/college) shall give an affidavit duly attested by Public Notary/Notary regarding their non-enrolment in any institution. Similarly, the applicants who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidate may submit their undertaking in the form of an affidavit in this regard duly attested by the Public Notary/Notary.
- v) Relevant certificate if the benefit of reserved category is being claimed (Annexure-IV or V or VI or VII or VIII as the case may be)
- vi) Sponsorship certificate, if applying as a sponsored applicant (Annexure IX or X as the case may be).

Note: The candidate must bring 5-6 colored Pass port size photographs at the time of counselling.

4.9 Admission against VCI seats

Admission shall be made as per recommendations of the VCI, subject to the fulfillment of minimum pre-admission qualifications prescribed by the University.

4.10 Admission against NRI/NRI sponsored/Industry sponsored seats:

- (i) The admission under this category will be given only to NRIs, their children/wards, NRI sponsored/Industry sponsored candidates. The eligibility requirements for this programme are the same as for general category candidates. However, the applicants, who have completed their qualifying examination or equivalent abroad, are required to submit a copy of their certificate/ transcript/marks sheet indicating grades and % equivalent marks, duly verified and certified by the Indian Embassy/ High Commission

in that country, stating that such examination is equivalent to the qualifying examination (10+2) of Indian Universities/Education Boards. Additionally, they will also be required to submit an application for obtaining the requisite equivalence certificate from the Registrar LLRUVAS, Hisar by paying a fee of US\$ 500 (non-refundable) through a bank draft in favour of the Comptroller, LLRUVAS, Hisar payable at any scheduled bank at Hisar.

- (ii) The NRI applicants or their children/wards seeking admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme will be considered for admission without appearing in the entrance test of the university provided they have passed 12th standard level examination with 50% marks in aggregate in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English, subject to verification of its equivalence to the 10+2 examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education/Board of School Education, Haryana by an appropriate authority. The details of subjects studied, grades and % equivalent marks obtained are to be furnished in the application form to facilitate admission committee in preparing the merit list.
- (iii) The preference of admission will be for NRIs or their children/wards followed by NRI sponsored and then Industry sponsored candidates. However, the fee structure will remain the same except the University Admission Fee and the College Development Fund. Fees from Industry sponsored candidates will be taken in equivalent of Indian Rupee. The conversion rate will be the average of prevailing buying and selling rates of US \$ at SBI on the day of deposition of fee. The payment will have to be made in cash or in the form of Bank Draft/Banker's cheque drawn in favour of Comptroller, LLRUVAS, Hisar.

Note : The applicants must attach an attested copy of sponsorship (Annexure IX or X) along with their applications while applying under these categories.

4.11 A candidate aggrieved by any decision of the Admission Committee/Registrar may appeal to the Vice-Chancellor within three days, who will examine the application with reference to rules and regulations and decision of the Vice-Chancellor in the matter shall be final.

- Note :**
1. Short duration has been provided for appeal as a time bound schedule is to be followed to complete the admissions.
 2. Admissions to B.V.Sc & A.H. programme of the University will be made by the Registrar. The Registrar shall accordingly register the students after payment of the prescribed fee and other charges. If it is found, at anytime, that a candidate obtained admission to this programme by misrepresentation of facts or that candidate had availed some benefit which was not due to him/her or if a candidate has been admitted due to an error, the Registrar may cancel his/her admission to this programme.

ADMISSION CAPACITY

1. The number of seats for the purpose of admission is decided by the Academic Council as per provisions under Section 15 of Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar Act No. 7 of 2010. All other provisions regarding the admission policy etc. are governed by the provisions of the above said Act and existing Statutes, and any other rule framed by the Competent Authority from time to time as prescribed under this Act.

Note: 3% horizontal reservation to Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of general, 1% out of scheduled castes and 1 % from backward class categories for admission to the various educational institutions of the Government and Government aided/Self-financing located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Class categories is concerned, year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes is given seats in the Academic year 2012, the other block i.e. B Block of Backward classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2013 and so on (Vide letter No.22/27/2004-2GSIII dated 20.10.2005 received from the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana).

Criteria for admission against the seats reserved for Ex-servicemen:

Seats under this category may be filled in the following order:

- a) Wives/sons/daughters of military persons killed in operation.
- b) Wives/sons/daughters of military persons permanently disabled in action.

Note: The above preference order shall be followed irrespective of merit in the entrance test. (The categorization of Block A and B of Scheduled Caste has been scrapped by Haryana Govt. vide letter No. 22/8/2004-3GSIII dated 7.6.2007).

For this purpose, a roster has been maintained with effect from academic year 2011-12. Fraction of each year shall be carried forward till total comes to one. then one seat shall be indicated in the Prospectus.

- Note : 1.** Benefit of reservation of Backward class categories shall not apply to the wards and the applicants belonging to creamy layer as defined by the State Government from time to time.
- 2.** In case, candidates are not available in one particular block of BC, the seats shall be filled up from the candidates of other block.

(iii) Persons with disability (PH): 3%

DEFINITION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITY

"Applicants having permanent disability of not less than 40%, provided the applicant is otherwise fit for a veterinarian's duty". Such applicants will have to bring a certificate at Annexure-VI from Chief Medical Officer of the District to which the candidate belongs. Such candidates will also have to appear before the Medical Board constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for determining the percentage of disability and for assessment whether they are fit to carry out the duties of veterinarian despite being handicapped. The findings of the University's Board shall be final, superseding the certificate already submitted by the applicant. However, VCI regulations shall be followed for the admission under this category i.e. the applicant should not suffer from the followings:

- a. Disability of total body including disability of chest/spine more than 50%.
- b. Disability of lower limb of more than 50%.
- c. Disability of upper limb.
- d. Visually handicapped including colour blindness and hearing disability.
- e. Progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- f. Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a Veterinarian.

Note: But in the event of the quota reserved for Persons with disability remaining unutilized due to non-availability of handicapped candidates, it may be offered to the Ex-servicemen and their wards, the dependents of freedom fighters and dependents of Operation Vijay to the extent of 1% each to these categories.

Prospectus shall be on sale from 1-6-2012 for M.V.Sc. & Ph.D. Programmes of 1st Semester and from 3.11.2012 for 2nd Semester for vacant seats of Ph.D. programme only.

Candidates seeking admission to M.V.Sc programme in the College of Vety. Sciences may apply on one Admission Form. The choice of discipline/subject normally depends upon eligibility and availability of seat in the discipline concerned.

Admission forms received after the scheduled date shall be rejected straightway. Preliminary scrutiny of the admission forms is done by the Registrar office. Forms will be rejected if counselling fee/late fee is not attached with admission form. Candidates should ensure submission of documents as per rule 1.3 below. Deficiencies are to be removed by the date fixed for first counselling failing which the candidate shall not be considered for admission. All eligible candidates must report themselves on the date and time for Counselling failing which they will have no claim for admission. No separate letter in this connection shall be issued.

Candidates are required to bring relevant original documents on the date of counselling (fixed for them, Annexure XI) failing which they shall be refused admission. Original documents of candidates admitted shall be retained by Registrar/Dean, PGS's offices and temporarily provided to the candidate on demand for a week or upto one day before next counselling, whichever is earlier and if not returned by the date committed, admission shall stand automatically cancelled. Finally, these will be returned through the Dean PGS within one month after cut off date/registration whichever is later.

Admissions will be completed at 2nd (final) counselling which will be the cut off date for admissions against vacant seats, if any.

Note 1. The Photographs (taken on or after 01-10-2011) should depict name and date of taking photo. It should be without cap and dark glasses. If the photographs are old, are not similar or are with cap or dark glasses or disfigured by attesting authority, the application shall be rejected.

2.2.4 Institutional Weightage

Weightage of 5% marks is granted to such candidates who have passed qualifying

examination from LLRUVAS/CCSHAU for admission to the programmes available in this university provided that no weightage shall be allowed for the programmes where admission is made on the basis of entrance test. Institutional weightage shall be in addition to the weightage listed in foregoing rules.

- 2.2.4.1 The weightage is only indicative and is subject to change from time to time.
- 2.2.4.2 The weightage should be added to the percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination, i.e., if a candidate has secured 50% marks in the qualifying examination and has obtained first position in a recognised National Championship/All India Inter-State Championship organised under the auspices of National Sports Federation/Association, 5% marks would be added to the percentage of marks obtained by him/her i.e. he/she would be treated as having secured 55% marks.
- 2.2.4.3 Those who are eligible for reservation are also eligible for weightage for a particular category, in addition to his/her placing in the reserved category.
- 2.2.4.4 Candidates can claim only one weightage (highest weightage) out of the weightages meant for sports category, co-curricular activities, NCC and NSS. Institutional weightage shall however be in addition.
- 2.2.4.5 Weightage for co-curricular activities, NCC and NSS shall be allowed for the achievements attained during the regular period of residential requirements of the qualifying degree programme.

3. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

3.1 M.V.Sc. Programme:

- 3.1.1 The minimum qualifications for admissions of fresh as well as in-service candidates excluding optional subjects shall be 60% marks (where OGPA is not given) or a grade point average of 6.0 (10.00 basis) in B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree.
- 3.1.2 The degree at graduation level must be recognized by Veterinary Council of India. The applicant must ensure before submitting the form that he/she fulfills the requirement in this regard failing which his/her admission shall be cancelled and university will assume no responsibility for any inconvenience/hardships to the candidate on this account. The candidate shall submit a notarized affidavit in this regard along with application.
- 3.1.3 Inservice candidates should apply through proper channel. However, an advance copy may be submitted by the candidate before last date of submission of application. The copy through proper channel must reach the office before the date of 1st counselling.

3.2 Ph. D. Programme

- 3.2.1 The minimum qualifications for admission of fresh as well as in-service candidates shall be 70% marks (where OGPA is not given) or a grade point average of 7.0 (10.00 basis) at Master's level in the subject concerned from a recognized University (special requirement of subjects for admission to various disciplines is given below). No weightage as specified in rule 2.2.1-4 will be given.

4. **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- 4.1. The eligible candidates shall be required to report on 01.08.2012 at 09.30 a.m. for MVSc and 04.08.2012 for Ph.D. in the committee room of the DEAN, PGS for counselling and further verification and submission of documents to the Admission Committee. Admission shall be allowed on the basis of merit in the qualifying degree and availability of seat(s).
- 4.2. The candidates admitted shall have to pay fee and other charges on the same day.
- 4.3. Same marks in merit list after addition of weightage, if any:
If there are two or more candidates scoring same marks in the merit amongst them the admission shall be decided on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. If in the qualifying examination, the percentage of marks remains the same, then the merit will be decided on the basis of lower board's examination. If still there is a tie, then the candidate senior in age will be considered higher in merit.
- 4.4. Every candidate who has deposited the fee and other charges must report for registration on due date, failing which he/she shall lose the claim of admission and his/her fee will also be forfeited.

5. **GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING ADMISSIONS**

- 5.1. No intimation letter regarding counselling or registration shall be sent to any candidate. Admission of foreigners shall, however, be made in absentia on the basis of documents received through the Competent Authority. Sponsoring Authority will be informed about admission of foreigners with a copy to the candidate.
- 5.2. The candidates shall deposit the fees and dues, get themselves medically examined from the Senior Medical Officer of the University, submit medical certificate on the same day to the Dean PGS and complete the registration on due date as indicated in Annexure-XI. Candidates found medically unfit shall not be allowed admission. The admission of those candidates, who failed to report registration on scheduled date, shall also stand cancelled and dues paid are not refundable.

- 5.3 The candidates shall be admitted as per roster system in Annexure-II. However, while filling the seats earmarked for general category, the combined merit list having reserved categories' candidates too, shall be considered. Any candidate who remains absent on being called or refuses to accept admission on his/her turn as per roster system shall lose his/her right of admission at that counselling.
- 5.4 Admission against reserved seats:
In case of seats reserved for different categories (excluding general category), the merit will be determined inter se amongst the Haryana domiciled candidates belonging to the respective categories. Roster system as in Annexure-II shall be followed for admitting the candidates belonging to various reserved categories. However, while filling the general category seats under roster system, the combined merit list having reserved categories' candidates too, shall be considered. Seats lying vacant in any reserved category due to non-availability of eligible candidates will be added to general category and filled up in 1st counselling itself, if possible.
- 5.5 The completion of admission process involves the following:
- Submission of all original documents along with attested copies and verification at the time of counselling.
 - Deposition of fee and other charges
 - Medical examination.
 - Registration on due date.
- Admission procedure will be completed only after registration.
- 5.6 Seats remaining vacant due to any reason at the first counselling or the seats fallen vacant subsequently due to any reason shall be filled in during 2nd counselling/cut off date for the admissions as indicated in Annexure-XI. There will be no admission after the cut off date and seat(s) still remaining vacant shall be treated as cancelled except the Ph.D. seats.
- 5.7 Presence of candidates:
Presence of the candidate is must for the following events failing which the admission shall be treated as cancelled and the dues already deposited shall stand forfeited and the seat considered vacant and filled up as per rules:
- At the time of counselling for admission at date and time indicated in Annexure-XI.
 - Medical examination.
 - Registration as per Annexure-XI.
- 5.8 Original and self-attested copies of the following documents are required to be deposited with the Admission Committee at the time of counselling and failure to produce any of the original documents shall make the candidate ineligible for the admission:
- Matric Certificate with Date of Birth and Father's/Mother's name.
 - 10+2 certificate or equivalent.
 - Haryana Resident Certificate (Annexure-III).

- iv) Character Certificate from the institute last attended. The applicants who have passed qualifying examination earlier and there is a gap of more than one year (other than the pursuit of studies in an institution/college) shall give an affidavit duly attested by Public Notary/Notary regarding their non-enrolment in any institution.
 - v) Relevant certificate if the benefit of reserved category is being claimed (Annexure-IV or V or VI or VII or VIII as the case may be)
For candidates seeking admission to M.V.Sc. programmes
 - vi) Bachelor's degree and transcript/DMC showing marks/OGPA with conversion formula, if only OGPA is mentioned.
For candidates seeking admission to Ph.D. programmes
 - vii) Master's degree and transcript showing marks/OGPA with conversion formula, if only OGPA is mentioned
- 5.9 A candidate aggrieved by any decision of the Admission Committee/Registrar may appeal to the Vice-Chancellor within three days, who will examine the application with reference to rules and regulations and decision of the Vice-Chancellor in the matter shall be final.
- Note :** 1. Short duration has been provided for appeal as a time bound schedule is be followed to complete the admissions.
- 5.10. Admissions to M.V.Sc & Ph.D. programme of the University will be made by the Registrar. The Registrar shall accordingly register the students after payment of the prescribed fee and other charges. If it is found, at any time, that a candidate obtained admission to this programme by misrepresentation of facts or that candidate had availed some benefit which was not due to him/her or if a candidate who was not otherwise eligible for admission has been admitted due to an error, the Registrar may cancel his/her admission to this programme.
- 5.11 Candidates must have completed master's programme and result notified or have completed their viva-voce examination by the date of counselling.
- 5.12 Applications of in-service candidates of LLRUVAS, accompanied by the certificate as at Annexure-XII must reach the Registrar through proper channel, by the last date prescribed. The candidates may, however, submit advance copy but must ensure submission of a copy through proper channel by the date of counselling.
- 5.13 The major and minor courses shall be according to the requirements for the particular programme to which a candidate is admitted. The courses required to be taken by the candidate in order to meet certain deficiencies shall be over and above the minimum requirements and these are called deficiency courses. These shall be entered in the programme of work in the appropriate columns. The deficiency courses have to be completed by the student before he/she is entitled to receive the degree and in each of these courses he/she shall be awarded 'S' or 'US' grade. The student must get 60% marks or more for getting 'S' grade in the deficiency course. However, the grade(s) obtained will not be counted towards the calculation of the OGPA.

5.14 At the time of selection/admission, the Dean/Registrar/Admission Committee shall also consider the past record of the candidate, concerning his/her conduct as a student/employee in this University or elsewhere. If the authority is satisfied that the applicant/student/ employee as the case may be, being considered for admission was involved in acts of indiscipline, organizing demonstration, involvement in criminal offences, specially involved in immoral aptitude, the Dean/ Registrar/Admission Committee may refuse admission to such a candidate.

6. ADMISSION CAPACITY

The number of seats for the purpose of admission is decided by the Academic Council as per provisions under Section 15 of Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar Act No. 7 of 2010. All other provisions regarding the admission policy etc. are governed by the provisions of the above said Act and existing Statutes, and any other rule framed by the Competent Authority from time to time as prescribed under this Act.

Admission to M.V.Sc./Ph.D programmes are made from 1st semester. Admission to Ph.D. programme for vacant seats is made from 2nd semester.

*The admission to M.V.Sc. (Animal Biotechnology) will be made by the JNU as per guideline of DBT(GOI). The students admitted under this Project will be awarded a studentship of Rs.8000/- per month.

** The DBT has approved to reserve two seats for the Haryana residents (out of intake capacity of 14) for admission in Animal Biotechnology. However, the admission of these two candidates will be done on merit of qualifying examination i.e. B.V.Sc. & A.H including weightage if any.

6.2. The candidates who have represented India in a recognized Inter-national Tournament/ Championship under the auspices of concerned Game Federation in the games listed at annexure XV shall be admitted against additional seats in PG programme provided they fulfill the eligibility criteria. Choice of discipline is left to the candidate subject to a maximum of one additional seat in a discipline. If there are more than one candidates opting for a discipline, choice of discipline would be allowed as per their inter-se merit."

Note: i) Only the performance of preceding three years in the games listed at annexure XV will be considered. The cut off date for counting preceding three years will be 30th June of the year of admission.

ii) Required eligibility performance will be considered only if the participation certificate of a lower level is attached or if for any reasons next lower championship has not taken place then a certificate to this effect from the concerned authorities has to be attached.

iii) Performance in Exhibition matches, Invitation tournaments etc. will not be considered for additional seats.

6.3 Only one ward of each LLRUVAS employees who dies while in service may be given admission (except Ph.D. Programme) only once (if interested) against additional seat(s) in PG programme provided he/she fulfils minimum eligibility conditions. Candidate once admitted to any programme shall not be allowed shifting on any ground.

6.4 A few nominees of Indian Council for Cultural Relations under cultural relations exchange programme from foreign countries be admitted in PG programmes against additional seats provided they fulfil the eligibility conditions.

6.5 On the recommendations of the concerned Heads of Departments, change of discipline within the College may be permitted in 2nd Semester of M.V.Sc programme within 15 days of registration, if the seats are available in the department in which the student wants to migrate. Such students should have the OGPA of 6.5 or above in the 1st semester.

7.1 DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS FOR M.V.SC PROGRAMME

Note: 3% horizontal reservation to Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of general. 1% out of scheduled castes and 1 % from backward class categories for admission to the various educational institutions of the Government and Government aided/Self-financing located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Class categories is concerned, year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes is given seats in the Academic year 2012, the other block i.e. B Block of Backward classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2013 and so on (Vide letter No.22/27/2004-2GSIII dated 20.10.2005 received from the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana).

Criteria for admission against the seats reserved for Ex-servicemen:

Seats under this category may be filled in the following order:

- c) Wives/sons/daughters of military persons killed in operation.
- d) Wives/sons/daughters of military persons permanently disabled in action.

Note: The above preference order shall be followed irrespective of merit.

(The categorization of Block A and B of Scheduled Caste has been scrapped by Haryana Govt. vide letter No. 22/8/2004-3GSIII dated 7.6.2007).

For this purpose, a roster has been maintained with effect from academic year 2011-12. Fraction of each year shall be carried forward till total comes to one, then one seat shall be indicated in the Prospectus.

- Note :
1. Benefit of reservation of Backward class categories shall not apply to the wards and the applicants belonging to creamy layer as defined by the State Government from time to time.
 2. In case, candidates are not available in one particular block of BC, the seats shall be filled up from the candidates of other block.
- (ii) Persons with disability (PH): 3%

DEFINITION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITY:

"Applicants having permanent disability of not less than 40%, provided the applicant is otherwise fit for a veterinarian's duty". Such applicants will have to bring a certificate at Annexure-VI from Chief Medical Officer of the District to which the candidate belongs. Such candidates will also have to appear before the Medical Board constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for determining the percentage of disability and for assessment whether they are fit to carry out the duties of veterinarian despite being handicapped. The findings of the University's Board shall be final, superseding the certificate already submitted by the applicant. However, VCI regulations shall be followed for the admission under this category i.e. the applicant should not suffer from the followings:

- a). Disability of total body including disability of chest/spine more than 50%.
- b). Disability of lower limb of more than 50%.
- c). Disability of upper limb.
- d). Visually handicapped including colour blindness and hearing disability.

- e). Progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
- f). Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a Veterinarian.

Note: But in the event of the quota reserved for Persons with disability remaining unutilized due to non-availability of handicapped candidates, it may be offered to the Ex-servicemen and their wards, the dependents of freedom fighters and dependents of Operation Vijay to the extent of 1% each to these categories.

iv) General category of Haryana residents 50%

7.2 Distribution of seats for Ph.D. programmes shall be as under :

(i) ICAR nominees 25%

(as defined in rule 2.1.2)

(ii) Haryana Resident Candidates: 75%

with further distribution as under :

(a) In-service candidates of LLRUVAS 20%

(at least one in each discipline)

(b) Rest of the seats shall be for general category (G. C.) of Haryana residents.

Note : 1. Admission against ICAR seats shall be finalized by the ICAR. Recommendations of the ICAR for filling up of seats of Ph.D. programme must reach and the candidates to report for admission by cut off date prescribed by this University.

Vacant seats (ICAR) of all the programmes, if any, shall be filled up in accordance with the guidelines of the ICAR.

2. As is clear from the number of seats indicated on pre pages, the seats are either for Haryana Residents or for the candidates who have appeared in the Test conducted by the ICAR and allowed admission during their counselling programme. However, the unfilled seats in all M.V.Sc and Ph.D. programmes may be filled up by the applicants of other States who have passed their Master's programme from a Constituent College of State Agricultural/Veterinary Universities or ICAR Institutes, if no eligible candidates are available from Haryana at the time of 2nd counselling. Such candidates may however report to the Admission Committee on cut off date when the position regarding the vacant seats shall be clear.
