Hon'ble Minister of Animal Husbandry and Dairying Department Haryana for CII Agri Business Mission. The D.G, AH&D signed MoU with Murdoch University, Australia for bilateral exchange programme. It was informed that e-tender is likely to be floated very soon and efforts are being made to start the construction work of university campus shortly. Four Assistant Professors have been appointed in CODST, a number of teachers and non-teaching employees of various categories have been promoted to their next level and some non-teaching employees granted the ACP scales as per university rules. The recommendations of 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission have been implemented in the university on the pattern of State Government for non-teaching employees. The admissions to the under graduate and post graduate programmes of the university have been completed. The University is thankful to the ACS, Finance for providing an independent audit team for LUVAS in a short span of time.
