The proposed revised guidelines were approved with the following modifications:

A. General norms for affiliation of a new private Veterinary College (Page A-21).

(i) Sr. No. 14 - Word 'LUVAS' be suffixed to Dean, COVS. The word 'of LUVAS' be also added after the model qualifications.

(ii) Sr. No. 16 - The fee structure shall be decided by the Government of Haryana.

(iii) Sr. No. 17 – To be substituted with the following:

The Institute/College shall submit an affidavit attested by 1<sup>st</sup> Class Magistrate to the effect that in case of deficiencies pointed out by VCI, the Govt. of Haryana may take over the Institute/College with all assets to run the B.V.Sc.&A.H. course for the admitted students.

- (i) Sr. No. 3 The word 'shape' prefixed to of a bank draft to be substituted with 'form'. The word '&' prefixed to Animal Sciences, Hisar to be substituted with 'and'.
