At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of Board of Studies and the following decisions were taken:

**Item No.1: Confirmation of proceedings of 223<sup>rd</sup> meeting of BOS.**

**Item No.2: Approval of course curriculum and time span for “Diploma in Dairy Technology” (DIDT)**

The “Diploma in Dairy Technology” (DIDT) Programme was approved in the 222<sup>nd</sup> meeting of BOS held on 7/3/12. In this meeting, it was decided that Dr.R.S.Dabur, HOD, LPT will act as Nodal Officer and the time frame for this Diploma Programme will be two years. The Dean, College of Agriculture & Technology raised some points with reference to this diploma programme through a letter. The Dean, College of Vety. Sciences apprised the House that he has answered all the queries point-wise.

**Item No. 3 Draft Prospectus 2012-13 for the “Diploma courses”**

Three diploma courses viz. i) **Veterinary and Livestock Development Diploma (VLDD)**, ii) **Diploma in Veterinary Laboratory Technology (DVLT)** and iii) **Diploma in Dairy Technology (DIDT)** are going to be started from the year 2012-13. It was decided that 5500 copies of the prospectus will be printed initially.

The contents of the draft prospectus have been approved with the following additions:

- i) If the seats belonging to General Category/In-service candidates/NRI/NRI sponsored/Industry sponsored candidates remain vacant even after second counselling. The same can be shifted inter-se by the Dean, College of Veterinary Sciences.
- ii) The Board of Studies authorized the Dean, COVS to fill up the seats within a period of two weeks, if remain vacant, even after 2<sup>nd</sup> counselling/cut off date.

**Item No.4: Implementation of changed pattern of examination.**

A decision was taken in the 221<sup>st</sup> meeting of BOS held on 27/1/12. The proceedings of which was circulated vide No.Van/12/88-110 dated 2/2/12. In this meeting the change in the pattern of examination was approved. But the date from which it was to be implemented was not decided. In this context a request from the students of College of veterinary Sciences which was signed by approximately 150 students was received on 6.4.12. The request states that the change in the pattern of examination and distribution of marks may not be implemented. The matter was discussed by the BOS at length and it was finally decided that the request of the students was genuine and therefore the agenda was deferred till further orders and the present pattern of examination will continue. The respective HOD will modify the internal examination question papers according to the on-going pattern. However, COE was authorized to modify the external examination at his own level. The invigilation duty for the internal as well as external examination will be taken care of by the respective Heads of the Departments in co-ordination with the COE.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
