Rule 3) After obtaining the NOC, the institution shall have to apply (Application form as in annexure 3) to the Director, IPVS, LUVAS within 120 days of obtaining the NOC for pre- affiliation inspection of the institution which is intended to evaluate infrastructural, technical, clinical, academic and financial capability of the institution seeking affiliation in keeping with the requirements prescribed. The applicant institution shall not start any academic activity including advertisement for admission under any circumstances before getting the affiliation from LUVAS. The institution shall be required to deposit along with the application, initial affiliation fee of Rs.3,50,000/- (Rupees three lakh fifty thousand only) and an inspection fee of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees seventy thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft in favor of Director IPVS, payable at Hisar. The University will exercise control over the institution/college as per Norms, Procedure and Guidelines for affiliation of a private institute/ College for starting VLD diploma course in the State of Haryana.
2.	Rule 4) The pre-affiliation inspection has to be necessarily carried out before 31st March provided the application along with required fee has been deposited latest by 28th February of the current year. 2nd Inspection may, if required, be done before the start of academic session. The affiliation will be subject to recommendations by the Inspection Committee to be constituted by Director, IPVS, LUVAS in consultation with the Dean, COVS with the approval of Vice-Chancellor, LUVAS. The Inspection Committee should have at least three members from faculty of different departments of COVS of the rank not below Associate Professor /equivalent. Each member will be from separate department. The senior most faculty member of the Inspection Committee will act as Chairman and the junior most will act as Member-Secretary. One Inspection Committee will inspect at the most three private VLDD institutions/colleges in a calendar year. Honorarium to members of inspection committee will be provided by the University as per rates approved from time to time. The Committee shall submit its report to Director, IPVS. The Director IPVS shall submit the report to the Board of Studies of the concerned constituent college for deliberation. The Board of Studies will submit the report to the Affiliation Committee along with its recommendations and the affiliation committee shall examine and place it before the Academic Council for decision. Renewal of affiliation in subsequent years will be subject to the recommendations by the Inspection committee as prescribed in rule 4 which shall visit the institution before 30th April of that year.

Rule no. 5, line no. 8

The bank guarantee of **Rupees** Fifty lakhs deposited by the affiliated Institutes will be retained by the Director, IPVS, LUVAS for a period of five years after the first batch of VLD diploma students admitted through LUVAS has passed out.

4. **Rule no. 6**

The renewal of affiliation in subsequent years will be subject to the recommendations by the Inspection Committee as prescribed in rule 4, which shall visit the institution before 30th April of that year. The institution shall have to deposit an inspection fee of Rs. 70,000/(Rupees seventy thousand only) by 28th February every year. The institution shall not issue any advertisement for admission pertaining to concerned academic year before the renewal of affiliation.

5. Rule no. 10

The candidate who has not appeared for the Entrance Test shall not be admitted to the diploma course under any category including management quota seats.

6. Rule no. 11

Process of Registration and Counselling for admission to VLD Diploma in the affiliated institutions will be **online/offline** & fees is to be deposited in the account of Director, IPVS, LUVAS Hisar as per prospectus **uploaded** at LUVAS website.

7. Rule no. 14

Entire process of conduct of final/end term examinations, evaluation and related **issues** for the diploma course shall be under the control and supervision of the Director IPVS, LUVAS, Hisar. "Annual theory examination of all the VLDD courses (LUVAS campus and affiliated Institutes/colleges) will be conducted by Controller of Examination, LUVAS at the Centre(s) fixed by LUVAS, Hisar. Annual practical examination of all the VLDD courses will be conducted by the respective Institutes/Colleges at their own campus, however, surprise checks for monitoring the proper conduct of practical examinations will be done by the Director of Institute of Para Veterinary Sciences. The date sheet of examination for both theory and practical will be prepared by the COE in consultation with Director, IPVS which will be uniformly followed by the Institutes/Colleges. Compiled results will be submitted to the Director, IPVS within a week after the end of practical examination by the In-charge, VLDD Section of LUVAS/ Principal/ Dean of Affiliated Institutes/ Colleges.

8. Rule no. 17

Minimum faculty strength for a diploma course for a batch of sixty students shall be one Principal, four faculty members as Veterinary Surgeons (Veterinary Graduates) and one English teacher having qualifications as mentioned below:
