| 27.2(b) | (i) The Master's students who have completed all the credit hours of course work and at least 50% of research work and are in 4th semester to fulfill his/her residential requirements, may be allowed to join service by Dean PGS and will be allowed to re-join their studies excluding the semester in which he / she had joined service, on production of 'NOC' from the employer within the prescribed time period. He / She will be allowed to re-join service after submission of thesis. (ii) The dropping may be allowed subject to the condition of completion of the programme within the time limit already prescribed for completion of Master's programme and no extension in the period will be given. | (i) The Master's students who have completed three semesters of his/her programme, all the credit hours of course work and at least 50% of research work may be allowed to join service by Dean PGS and will be allowed to re-join their studies excluding the semester in which he / she had joined service, on production of 'NOC' from the employer within the prescribed time period. He / She will be allowed to re-join service after submission of thesis. (ii) The discontinuation may be allowed subject to the condition of completion of the programme within the time limit already prescribed for completion of Master's programme and no extension in the period will be given.
