The matter regarding conduct of PCE oral examination of six (6) Ph.D. students who discontinued study after written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) of Minor and Major subjects to join as Veterinary Surgeon in Animal Husbandry and Dairying Department, Govt. of Haryana was placed before the 66th meeting of RIC vide Agenda Item No. 66 RIC-5. The RIC discussed the matter at length and deferred the same.

Since multiple entry/exist options in Masters' and Ph.D. Programmes have been introduced in the University, student can opt to discontinue his/her studies at any stage after successful completion of the first semester of his/her studies. The Doctoral student who discontinues his/her study after written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) of Minor and Major subjects, his/her PCE oral examination may be conducted during discontinuation period to complete the process of Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE).

In view of the above, the draft amendment in the <u>Rule 8.2(a) of Chapter III and Rule</u>

8.3(a) of Chapter-III-A of the University Calendar Volume-II proposed is as under: -

Addition of the point no. xii) in the Rule No. 8.2(a) of Chapter-III and Rule No. 8.3(a) of Chapter-III-A of the University Calendar Volume-II

xii) If a student has successfully passed the major and minor written preliminary comprehensive examination (PCE), the oral PCE may be conducted during the discontinued period of the doctoral programme in case the student discontinues his/her doctoral programme with permission after written PCE.

The RIC discussed the matter at length and recommended to place the matter before the worthy Vice-Chancellor for seeking approval to place the same before the ensuing meeting of Academic Council for consideration and decision, please.
