The Worthy Vice-Chancellor has approved the following amendments in Chapter-XXIV of LUVAS Statutes subject to Ex-post facto approval/ratification by Board of Management (BOM) in the next BOM meeting:

Powers to withdraw affiliation:

4. The affiliation granted to a private be withdrawn college/institute can temporarily or permanently at any time by the University as and when violation of any provisions or notifications issued by the University/Govt. of Haryana and VCI/ICAR or any other appropriate authority, and conditions laid down in Annexure-II comes to its notice. No suit, prosecution or other legal proceedings shall lie against the University or State Govt. or any officer or employee or any other person authorized by the State Govt./the University for anything which is done or intended to be done in good faith under the guidelines/rules as in clause 3 above or to the notifications issued by the University from time to time.

Application form for grant of affiliation

to a private College/institute:

25. Complete name and address of the State Public Information Officer and Appellate Authority to fulfill obligations under the Right to Information Act, 2005.

Amended Rule Powers to withdraw affiliation:

4. The temporary affiliation granted to a private college/institute can be withdrawn at any time by the University. However permanent affiliation shall be withdrawn de-recognition only after by VCI/Central government and with the prior approval by the Govt. of Haryana on the recommendation of University as and when violation of any provisions of the rules, guidelines or notifications issued by the University/Govt. of Haryana and VCI/ICAR or any other appropriate authority, and conditions laid down in Annexure-II comes to its notice. No suit, prosecution or other legal proceedings shall lie against the University or State Govt. or any officer or employee or any other person authorized by the State Govt./the University for anything which is done or intended to be done in good faith under the guidelines/rules as in clause 3 above or to the notifications issued by the University from time to time.

A.10. Once any institute/college granted affiliation, it shall be mandatory for the college/institute to implement the directions/instructions/ guidelines appropriate authority to maintain the standards and safeguard interests of the stakeholders including students, faculty, non-teaching employees and all interested, failing which, such college/institute will be liable to penal action. If the University is of the view that а private veterinary college/institute has violated anv provisions of the rules, guidelines, instructions or notifications issued by University, Government of Harvana, VCI/UGC/ICAR or any other agency, it may take any of the following actions:

i) Warning to the college/institute to implement expeditiously the directions/instructions/guidelines of the University and VCI.

A.10. Once any institute/college is granted affiliation, it shall be mandatory for the college/institute implement to directions/instructions/ guidelines of the University, any other appropriate or authority to maintain the academic standards and safeguard interests of the stakeholders including students, faculty, non-teaching employees and all interested, failing which, such college/institute will be liable to penal action. If the University is of the view that a private veterinary college/institute has violated any provisions of the rules, guidelines, instructions or notifications issued by University, Government of Haryana, Govt. India/VCI, it may take anyone of the following actions if not satisfied with the compliance report submitted by the college after granting reasonable opportunity/time:

i) Warning to the college/institute to implement expeditiously the directions/instructions/guidelines of the University and VCI.

- ii) Financial fine up to a maximum amount of Rs. 20 lakhs and such a fine shall be recoverable as arrears of land revenue.
- iii) Stoppage of fresh admission in the forthcoming sessions.
- iv) Temporary withdrawal of affiliation.
- v) Withdrawal of affiliation (permanent).
- ii) Financial fine up to a maximum amount of Rs.100000/- to be paid within a month. Such a fine shall be recoverable as arrears of land revenue.

- iv) Withdrawal of Temporary affiliation.
- v) Withdrawal of Permanent affiliation*
- *Permanent affiliation shall be withdrawn only after de-recognition by VCI/Central government and with the prior approval by the Govt. of Haryana on the recommendations of University.
- A.5. The college shall appoint a regular Principal/Dean. The faculty/teaching staff, to be recruited by the college/institute should have essential qualifications and experience as prescribed of University/Govt. Haryana/VCI, ICAR/UGC for the first year B.V.Sc.&A.H. class before starting admissions. The selection procedure shall be as per the guidelines of State Govt./affiliating University as applicable. Nominee(s) of Vice-Chancellor shall be on the selection committee. The selections shall be done after public advertisements in two national newspapers and college website. The college/institute shall provide the advertisement copy to the University alongwith a request to nominate the VC's nominee at least 10 days before the interview. Sitting charges of Rs. 2500/-(for each interview day) and transport facility shall be provided by the private institute/college to the VC nominee in the selection committee for recruitment of faculty. The University may amend sitting charges with passage of time.
- A.5. The college shall appoint a regular Principal/Dean. The faculty/teaching staff, to be recruited by the college/institute should have essential qualifications and experience prescribed as University/Govt. of Haryana/VCI, ICAR/UGC for the first year B.V.Sc.&A.H. class before starting admissions. The selection procedure shall be as per the guidelines of State Govt./affiliating University applicable. Nominee(s) of Vice-Chancellor shall be on the selection committee. The selections shall be done after public advertisements in two national newspapers and college website. The college/institute shall provide the advertisement copy to the University along with a request to nominate the VC's nominee at least 10 days before the interview.

A.14. The University may appoint such number of visitors/inspectors, as it may deem necessary to inspect any aspect of the affiliated college/institute without any prior notice. The visitors/inspectors shall have the powers for photography/ videography/seeking required documents like pay slips of staff, appointment letters, advertisements for recruitment of faculty and other staff, leave records of faculty and staff, bills of various purchases & attendance records etc. but may not interfere with the conduct of any training or examination. They shall submit the inspection report to the Vice-Chancellor through the Registrar.

A.14. The University may appoint such number of visitors/inspectors, as it may deem necessary to inspect any aspect of the affiliated college/ institute by giving two weeks notice. The visitors/ inspectors shall have the powers for photography/ videography/ seeking required documents like pay slips of staff, appointment letters, advertisements for recruitment of faculty and other staff, leave records of faculty and bills of various purchases & attendance records etc. but may not interfere with the conduct of any training or examination. Thev shall submit inspection report to the Vice-Chancellor through the Registrar.

A.16. The Trust/Society/College/Waqf shall be bound to respond to the provisions of RTI Act-2005, and operate in a transparent way with respect to all affairs of the college.

10. A sum of Rs. Four lakhs per class per year with an incremental increase of Rs. 40,000/- per year per class will be charges annually, as administrative expenses, from the affiliated College before the beginning of each session in the shape of a bank draft drawn in favour of the Comptroller, LUVAS, Hisar.
