

PROCEEDINGS OF THE 81st MEETING OF RESIDENT INSTRUCTION COMMITTEE (RIC) HELD ON 15.07.2026 AT 07:15 A.M. IN THE OFFICE OF DEAN, PGS, LUVAS, HISAR

At the outset, the Chairman, welcomed all the Hon'ble members and special invitees and wished that the contribution of members in the meeting will be constructive and useful.

Thereafter, the following agenda items were discussed and decision taken thereof:

- Agenda item No. 81 RIC-1:** Confirmation of the proceedings of the 80th meeting held on 10.06.2026.
Confirmed
- Agenda item No. 81 RIC-2:** Action taken report on the proceedings of 80th meeting held on 10.06.2026.
Noted and approved
- Agenda Item No. 81 RIC-3:** Reconsideration of the case for grant of post facto permission to M.V.Sc. student Dr Vinay Kumar, Admn. No. 2023V19M (VGO), for registration for thesis viva-voce examination.

It is submitted that the case of grant of post facto permission to Dr Vinay Kumar Admn. No. 2023V19M, for registration for thesis viva-voce examination was placed before the 79th meeting of RIC vide agenda Item No. 79RIC-3 titled "Post facto permission to M.V.Sc. student Dr Vinay Kumar, Admn. No. 2023V19M (VGO), regarding registration for thesis viva-voce examination" for consideration and decision.

In view of the above, RIC discussed the matter at length and recommended that

1. Post facto permission may be granted to M.V.Sc. student Dr. Vinay Kumar, Admission No. 2023V19M (VGO), for registration for the thesis viva-voce examination with payment of a late fee of ₹300 per day from the date of commencement of classes of the 2nd Semester, 2025–26 (i.e. 04.05.2026), up to 22.05.2026, along with a nominal fee of ₹2,000.
2. The post facto permission granted in respect of the aforesaid student shall be treated as a one-time measure only and shall not be quoted or considered as a precedent in any future case.

Further, RIC recommended to place the matter before the worthy Vice-Chancellor for seeking approval subject to the ratification by the Academic Council in its ensuing meeting.

In view of the above, the agenda item was placed before the Worthy Vice-Chancellor vide Green Sheet No. DP/LUVAS/412/33032/2026–2027 dated 03.06.2026 for approval subject to ratification by the Academic Council. However, the Worthy Vice-Chancellor forwarded the matter to the Dean, COVS, with directions to obtain explanations from the HoD, VGO, and the Major Advisor regarding the lapse that occurred due to the non-registration of the student for the viva-voce examination.

Pursuant to the directions of the Worthy Vice-Chancellor, the Dean, COVS, sought explanations from the HoD, VGO, and Dr Jasmer (Major Advisor), Assistant Professor, Department of VGO. In response, the concerned officials submitted their explanations to the office of the Dean, COVS.

The Dean, COVS, submitted the case, along with the explanations of the HoD, VGO, and Dr. Jasmer, to the Worthy Vice-Chancellor in continuation of the green sheet referred to above, for kind consideration and further orders in the matter.

In light of the above, the Worthy Vice-Chancellor ordered that:

“Dr Vinay Kumar, Admn. No. 2023V19M (VGO), is allowed for registration of thesis viva-voce examination ex-post facto without late fee. However, the issue be again discussed in the RIC for giving suitable recommendation so that no such lapse occur at the level of student, advisor, HOD concerned and Dean, PGS”.

In pursuance of the orders passed by the worthy Vice-Chancellor, necessary order regarding ex-post facto permission to Dr Vinay Kumar, Admn. No. 2023V19M (VGO) for registration of thesis viva-voce examination was issued by the office of Dean, PGS vide Endst. No. LUVAS/PGS/Acad/2026/1540-1550, dated 16.06.2026.

It is also pertinent to mention here that an explanation was also sought by the office of Dean, PGS from Dr Jasmer (Major Advisor), Assistant Prof., through HoD, VGO.

Further, as per the orders of the Worthy Vice-Chancellor, the case is required to be discussed again in the RIC for giving suitable recommendation so that no such lapse occur at the level of student, advisor, HOD concerned and Dean, PGS.

Therefore, in view of the position explained above, the matter of agenda item was placed before the RIC for consideration and decision.

The RIC deliberated upon the matter in detail and unanimously recommended the following:

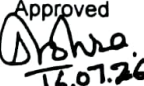
- i) All students shall register themselves on the scheduled date of registration as notified in the Academic Calendar for the respective academic year.
- ii) The Major Advisor shall ensure that all registration rules are strictly complied with at the time of registration. The Major Advisor shall also apprise the students of the registration rules prescribed in the University Calendar, Volume II, pertaining to the PG Programmes.
- iii) The concerned Head of the Department (HoD) shall ensure that all concerned students are duly informed of the semester registration schedule as notified in the Academic Calendar for the respective academic year.
- iv) The Office of the Dean, PGS shall, before scheduling the Final/Thesis Viva-Voce Examination of a PG student, ensure that the student has been duly registered for the semester in which the Final/Thesis Viva-Voce Examination is to be conducted.
- v) In addition to the above points, all the members of the RIC were also of view that Rule 2.2(a) of Chapter III-A of the University Calendar Volume-II, needs to be reviewed in the next meeting of RIC to prevent such lapses in the future. Rule 2.2(a) is reproduced below:

2.2(a) Advisement and registration (Appendix-I) without late fee on the prescribed date (s) which shall be one or two days prior to the commencement of classes. However, registration for thesis submission and/ or viva-voce shall be allowed with a nominal fee of Rs. 2000/- during the scheduled date of registration of the semester.

Further, the RIC recommended that the matter be submitted to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor for kind consideration and approval to place the same before the ensuing meeting of the Academic Council for its consideration and approval.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
